Extension: 1 year

After the Vocational Training of 1,5 year the student can participate in a 1-year Extension Study Program for his Master Degree II.

The purpose of this Extension is to guide the student how to facilitate consultations in Vedic Astrology to a client. In the past years students all over the world were able to start their own consultancy practice, but guidance in how to give the consultations in a practical way turned out to be very valuable. Another part of the Extension is to learn about how to use the Vedic Moon Calendar (Patra or Panchanga). This part is called the science of Muhurta.
